

Foundation : Poly Cup Dragon



The Dragon and Lion dances are traditional dances in the Chinese culture and are usually performed during Chinese New Year. While the dragon symbolizes supernatural power, goodness, fertility and dignity, the lion signifies courage, stability and superiority. Both the dances are performed with the accompaniment of musical instruments such as gongs, drums and cymbals.

Students from Foundation Year studied different types of lines and how they can use these lines to create patterns on polystyrene cups. With the help of some senior year students, these poly cups were strung together to form the bodies of three dragons with heads, tails and colourful streamers.

These students are now practicing the lion and dragon dances so that they can perform in front of the assembly in a few weeks' time.
