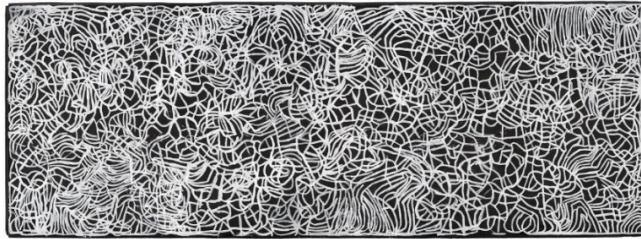


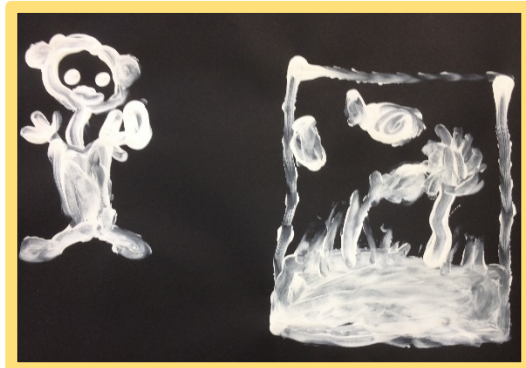


Foundation Year Finger Painting

Students studied and discussed the work of Aboriginal painter, Emily Kngwarreye, especially 'The Big Yam Dreaming'. This art piece depicts a yam plant which she finger painted on a 3m x 9m canvas. It is painted in bold white on black canvas. Using their prior knowledge gained from their classroom inquiry, students in Foundation Year discussed the different roles animals play in people's lives and their responsibility for the well-being of animals, especially the ones they keep as pets. Students then sketched a picture to show how they care for their pets before finger painting it in white, on to black cover paper.
