School Level	Suggested Time (4 days per week)
FOUNDATION - Daily reading, by the student, to the student, with the student, including, <i>Reading Eggs</i> - Alphabet and sight word recognition activities, progressing to spelling tasks, including SMART Spelling activities - organising a Show and Tell oral presentation - Maths activities, to reinforce the classroom numeracy focus including <i>Mathletics</i>	15 minutes
JUNIOR SCHOOL - Daily reading by the student, to the student, with the student, including, <i>Reading Eggs</i> - Sight word recognition activities and SMART Spelling tasks - Organising oral presentations with a designated focus - Maths activities, to reinforce classroom numeracy focus, including <i>Mathletics</i> - Research, collection of materials/resources and rehearsing presentations to support classroom inquiries	20 minutes
MIDDLE SCHOOL - Daily independent reading, including, <i>Reading Eggs and</i> - weekly SMART Spelling / word work - Maths activities to reinforce classroom numeracy focus, including <i>Mathletics</i> - Research, collection of materials/resources and rehearsing presentations to support classroom inquiries	25 – 30 minutes
SENIOR SCHOOL - Daily independent reading, <i>Reading Eggs</i> - Weekly SMART Spelling / word work - Maths activities, to reinforce classroom numeracy focus, including <i>Mathletics</i> - Research, collection of materials/resources and rehearsing presentations to support classroom inquiries	30 – 45 minutes
